Announcement for Applications Submission

The Department of Digital Systems of the Faculty of Information and Communication Technologies of the University of Piraeus and the Institute of Informatics and Telecommunications of NCSR "Demokritos" jointly organize and operate the Interinstitutional Postgraduate Program (IPP) titled "Artificial Intelligence".

The IPP is accepting applications for enrollment in the Postgraduate **Program for the academic year 2025-2026** (courses commence in October 2025).

Eligible candidates must hold a first-cycle degree from a Higher Education Institution (AEI) or Technological Educational Institute (TEI) in a field related to the subject of the Program, either from a domestic institution or a recognized foreign institution.

Applicants must complete and submit their application through the Electronic Submission System for Postgraduate Applications "Aristyllos" at the following link:

Required Documents

Applicants must submit the following documents via the Electronic Submission System:

- 1. Application form
- 2. Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- 3. Certified copy of degree/diploma or proof of graduation¹
- 4. Official transcript, including the degree/diploma grade (for each academic qualification)
- 5. Two recommendation letters related to the applicant's academic career (preferably from the academic environment)
- 6. Copy of the undergraduate thesis or diploma thesis (if applicable)
- 7. Copies of publications in journals or conference proceedings (if applicable)
- 8. Proof of professional or research activity in a field relevant to the IPP (if applicable)
- 9. Certified copy of an English language proficiency certificate
- 10. Certified proof of sufficient knowledge of the Greek language (for foreign applicants)
- 11. Photocopy of both sides of the applicant's ID card
- 12. Recent passport-sized photograph
- 13. Declaration of authenticity (<u>issued via the Gov.gr platform</u> or certified at a KEP or Police Department in Greece) stating that all submitted documents are genuine.

If an applicant is accepted into the IPP, they must submit all required documents in certified hardcopy format to the Secretariat of the Department of Digital Systems at the University of Piraeus during the registration period.

¹¹ If the relevant document is not available at the time of application, candidates must complete their studies before registering in the IPP in October 2025 and submit the document at the time of registration.







Application Submission Process

Applications and supporting documents are submitted exclusively online. In case of difficulties in uploading or missing documents, applicants may contact the Secretariat of the IPP.

Applicants must ensure that all required documents, including the two (2) recommendation letters, are submitted on time.

If an applicant is accepted into the IPP, they must submit all required documents in certified hardcopy format to the Secretariat of the Department of Digital Systems at the University of Piraeus during the registration period.

Applications are submitted exclusively online.
